Trans Mountain expansion a 'go'

While the Canadian gov't has bought Kinder Morgan's TM pipeline, in BC 1191 provincial permits are required for the Trans Mountain expansion project, with many involving First Nations consultation. To date, 756 permit applications have been submitted to permitting agencies. Of these, 220 have been approved and permits issued. The remaining 536 submitted permit applications are being reviewed. Another 435 permits have yet to be submitted by Kinder Morgan Canada Ltd./contractor.

All permits submitted must align with the 37 conditions outlined in the provincial environmental certificate, as well as the 157 conditions detailed in the National Energy Board's approval.

'Flood solutions' mtg

About 40 people attended a neighbourhood meeting last week, to try to solve the flooding problem for property owners along the rivers. There were many suggestions for a solution — dykes, dredging the river channel, tributary control (holding back water further up stream), a flood spillway, raising Voght St. — but one thing was generally agreed upon: over the years, the river has been encroached upon by homes & industry creating a narrower channel & over-developed flood plain.

Whatever the solution might be, it's clear that the authorities will have to be on-board with any plan. And that makes it complicated. Unfortunately with major damage to several homes, disastrous for some homeowners, there's not much time to corral all the players & start to put in place a plan (with short term & long term goals) to mitigate next spring's high water.

Next step is to formalize the group & plan a presentation to City Council & the Ministry of Natural Resource Operations. They will also set up a Facebook group as a means to connect & share information.

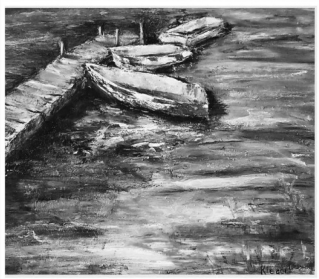
