‘Theft of fences’ update

Three Surrey, BC men have plead guilty to theft & mischief charges relating to the theft of boards, being sold to a firm in the Lower Mainland that resells the wood as ‘barn boards’, which are now a valuable commodity. Damage to the fencing was estimated at \$40,000.

Peter Gordon Dahl was given a suspended sentence & 1 year of probation; William Robert Neff was sentenced to 85 days in jail, 1 year of probation and ordered to pay restitution of \$3335.85 to Min. of Hwys; Robert Allan Richardson was sentenced to a conditional sentence of 18 months and ordered to pay restitution of \$13,333.34 to the Coquihalla Cattle Company.

On August 24, 2016, Merritt RCMP received a call in relation to a theft of fence boards near the Comstock Rd interchange. It was believed that the thieves would be returning to steal additional fencing in the early morning hours. A Merritt RCMP member attended the area to set up surveillance equipment and caught the thieves literally red handed.

Once it’s up and running they also plan to offer library programming in the Mobile Library. 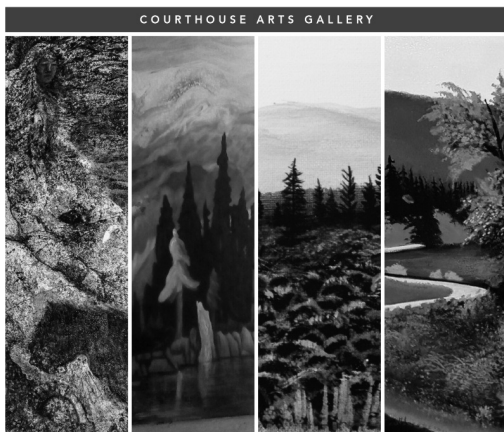

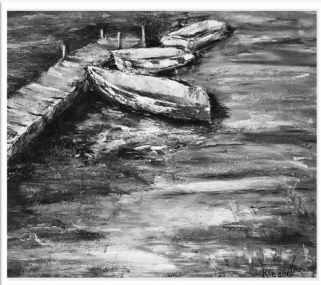
