Theatre project takes another turn

Tomorrow, during the regular meeting, the NV Community Theatre Society will present a different option for their cinema/theatre project to Merritt City Council.

The Theatre Society proposes to split the project into 2 separate venues on 2 separate sites: The movie theatre portion will remain at the present proposed site. Reducing the footprint of the building will significantly reduce the cost of this portion of the project and allow for expanded on-site parking – a move which will positively impact the business centre. The performing arts portion of the project will now be proposed as an extension to the Civic Centre, and belong to the City.

The Society suggests it would be willing to continue to spearhead fundraising efforts through a third-party relationship similar to the successful Rural Dividend Fund application for \$500,000.

To date, the Theatre Society has raised over \$1,000,000 recognizing that amount is still insufficient to allow the project to begin construction. The group hopes that the concept changes that may help to push the project forward to a speedier conclusion.

Govt support for Bass Coast Festival

The festival was expected to attract 5,500 people, and generate more than \$450,000 in economic benefits for Merritt. The government provided \$45,000 to help organizers promote the festival.

“This special event is a great asset for the City of Merritt, and I’m proud our government is supporting it,” said Lisa Beare, Minister of Tourism, Arts and Culture. “The Bass Coast Festival is helping make Merritt’s reputation as a top destination for visitors who love music, art, and nature — and it provides an important boost for local tourism.”

Government funding for the Bass Coast Festival was provided through the Tourism Events Program, which supports events that raise awareness of BC’s tourism experiences, and inspires people from around the world to visit the province. These events also generate tourism and economic activities in regions throughout BC.

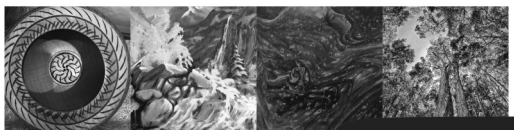

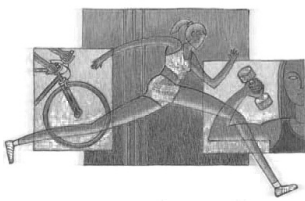
