Changes for recycling at Low Nic Eco-Depot

The TNRD has rolled out changes to its solid waste facilities, related to the disposal of recyclables, which will have to be separated into 6 different categories at all solid-waste facilities in the TNRD.

The first TNRD waste facilities to see changes to accommodate source separation of recyclables are the Lower Nicola Eco-Depot, Louis Creek Eco-Depot & Cache Creek Transfer Station.

When dropping off at these sites, you will be asked to separate your recyclables and dispose of them in appropriate bins:

1. Paper and cardboard
2. Containers (plastic, metal and paper)
3. Plastic bags and overwrap
4. White foam packaging
5. Coloured foam packaging
6. Glass bottles and jars.

The changes are a result of the agreement the TNRD has entered into with the provincial stewardship program Recycle BC, responsible for the recycling of residential packaging and printed paper throughout BC. It shifts the cost of recycling away from taxpayers and back onto producers. To conform to Recycle BC's standards, all TNRD solid waste facilities must move to source-separated recycling. Addicted to air conditioning?

British Columbians seeking refuge from the summer heat are increasingly turning to air conditioning, according to a new report by BC Hydro that reveals A/C use in the province has more than tripled to 34% since 2001. This upward trend will likely continue.

Running a central air conditioner for 9 hours a day over the summer costs around \$300, compared to just \$6 for a fan for the same amount of time. A recent survey commissioned by BC Hydro also found 93% of British Columbians are adding to their energy bills by setting A/C units lower than the BC Hydro-recommended 25°C.

For every degree lower an air conditioner is set, it increases cooling costs by 3%. And, more than 40% of British Columbians surveyed said they always or sometimes leave their air conditioners running when they are not at home.













Only 1/2 surveyed said they close the windows or doors when the temperature outside is hotter than the temperature inside.

About 25% of those surveyed do not shade windows. Shading windows can block out up to 65% of the heat. 37 % of respondents leave fans on when they are not at home. Fans do not cool the air, but they do have a cooling effect on the skin.
