Grand Chief Percy Joe**

Shackan's Grand Chief Percy Joe is a hereditary and elected chief of the Scw'exmx, serving his nation for 47 years until his recent retirement.

He is one of the founders of NVIT — one of only two schools of its kind in the country governed by Indigenous peoples. A champion of rights and title, he created unique reconciliation partnerships and approaches grounded in traditional knowledge and Indigenous wisdom and governance.

Chief Percy Joe will be awarded the Order of BC, along with the other 13 recipients, at a special celebration on Sept. 20 at Government House in Victoria.


The New World chinese

British Researcher Gavin Menzies, in his book, 1421: *The Year China Discovered America*, presents the case for a Chinese visit to America in the year 1421, 71 years before Columbus. The voyage was led by Zheng He. Yet, author and researcher John Ruskamp speculates that the Chinese people were present in America long before 1421, and prior to the end of the Shang Dynasty in 221 BC. In his paper, *Ancient Chinese Rock Writing Confirm Early Trans-Pacific Interaction*, he suggests that the Chinese people left behind several symbols on rocks. The rock carvings show an ancient Chinese writing system. Ruskamp discovered over 80 such carvings—in New Mexico, Arizona, Utah, Nevada, California, Oklahoma, and Ontario.

In 1972, Dr. Harris discovered an ancient map in South Korea. This map, now called the Harris Map, shows the location of a mythical land the Chinese people named "Fu Sang". To Dr. Harris' amazement, on this map, "Fu Sang" rests exactly where North America should be. Hui Shen, a Chinese monk, in 499 AD, claimed that he spent many decades in the land of "Fu Sang".

The Shan Hai Jing (the Legends of Mountains and Seas), compiled over 4000 years ago, discusses a landmass a distance of 10 000 miles from the East of China, believed to be America. The collection of writings continues to describe what researchers believe is the Grand Canyon. Moreover, *the Shan Hai Jing* describes flora, minerals, and fauna characteristic of the Americas.

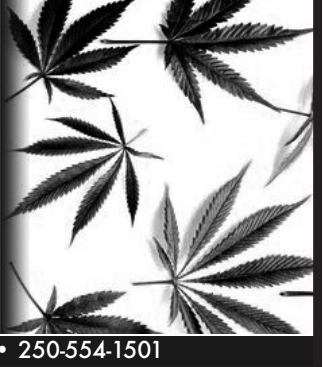

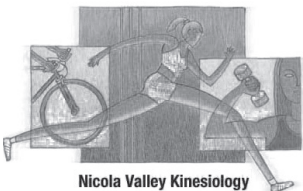
