**145 new BC fires  
started Saturday**

A special air quality statement is in effect for our region — as well as most of the province — with just ‘smoke’ in to-day & tonight’s forecast. Yesterday & last evening it hung in the air like fog.

The Juliet Creek fire, off the Coquihalla 47 kms southwest of town, ignited Wednesday because of lightning. The estimated size of the fire was not able to be updated yesterday because heavy smoke in the area reduced visibility. By Saturday it had grown to 600 hectares, but officials expect the size to grow significantly once the smoke clears and they are able to get a more accurate perimeter mapping. An evacuation alert was issued Friday and was upgraded to an evacuation order in the Murray Lake area, on Saturday afternoon.

Lightning strikes on Saturday also started small fires on the Coldwater Reserve and farther south along the Coquihalla at Shouz Creek, as well as at Spisus-Jack Swartz Creek.

The Gottfriedsen Mountain fire discovered on Thursday is estimated at 550 hectares, and an evacuation order remains in effect for a large area north of the Okanagan Connector.

The Cariboo, Southeast Fire Centre & Northern Vancouver Island were hit hard by the weekend’s thunderstorms.

**Country Music Hall of Fame goes digital**

Friday evening, the Country Music Hall of Fame unveiled their new interactive display that features the 100+ CCM Hall of Fame Inductees — bios, video clips and music. Software developer Ryan Meech was on hand to present the project and his innovations. He explained that as a Boston boy, he had little knowledge of country music, let alone Canadian country music stars. But after compiling & editing more than 1000 digital entries he probably is now one of the top 10 Canadian country music experts in the country!

One of Ryan’s most interesting innovations is the laser screen cover that converts the regular huge tv (originally donated by City Furniture several years ago) into a touch-screen for the ‘interactive’ component. This saved the society thousands!

The project brings the music museum into the digital age & will give new life to the facility, with an opportunity to keep visitors a reason to linger.

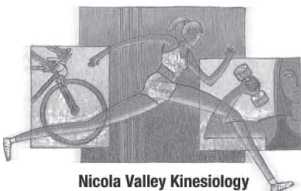
