Wildfire update
State of emergency

The Canadian Armed Forces says 170 of its troops arrived in BC last night, to help fight wildfires burning across the province. A detachment of Edmonton-based troops will operate out of both Kelowna and Merritt.

The military will first be put to work supporting the BC Wildfire Service in combatting the Gottfriedson Mtn Fire.

All 6 regional fire centres in the province are continuing to experience heightened fire activity. As of Aug 14, there are 566 fires burning in BC and there have been over 1,820 fires since the start of the season (April 1st), destroying 3,800-sq km of timber and bush.

Currently, more than 3,372 firefighters and contractors are actively engaged in fighting fires in all fire regions of the province. This includes 1,427 BC contract personnel, as well as 436 out-of-province personnel from AB, NB, NWT, QC, SK, Parks Canada, Australia, Mexico & New Zealand. Ground crews continue to be supported by 213 aircraft.

Weeks of fire season remain, and forecasts are for continued hot & dry conditions. Much of the province is currently facing a high-to-extreme fire danger rating. If you see a fire you think hasn't been reported, call 1 800-663-5555 toll free or *5555 off a cell phone.
