Over the past several years, I was fortunate enough to develop friendships with professional First Nations women, and it didn’t take too long before noticing the resilience in their eyes and the confidence in their stride. This resilience and stride I’ve seen before, as I’ve spent time with many powerful and world renowned people, but the difference is that the struggle of the Indigenous woman is ten times more. For this reason, I make note.

We all struggle and each person’s struggle is worth writing about, yet, we must be honest with ourselves and the tribulations of a First Nations woman are much more. They must climb the highest mountain before they’re recognized by the world, whereas those who occupy the center of the Bell Curve need only hike a hill. And this mountain they climb barefoot, against the cold wind, and with the weight of their nation on their shoulders—all the while, remaining still a delicate flower. It’s as if they have a superpower.

This superpower I’ve attempted to identify but no luck. They’re keeping it a secret. I thought perhaps I might borrow it and save the planet, because this is the potential of the strong Indigenous woman.

Their journey is ten times longer and harder. Their suffering is ten times more. Yet, when I sit across the table from them, I see an unscathed flower. How is this possible? Please my sisters, share with me your superpower.


