## TMX gearing up again

With the dismissal of an application by the City of Burnaby, to overturn a court ruling preventing the city from blocking the construction of the Trans Mountain pipeline expansion, the company is gearing up again, with the confirmation of Surerus Murphy Joint Venture as the contractor for our area — between Black Pines and the Coquihalla Summit (Spread 5A). SMJV has a history of delivering large pipeline projects in challenging conditions, and has worked on pipeline projects in our area over that last couple years.

Meanwhile in Edson AB, 2-day safety and project orientation 'kickoff' sessions for contractors were held recently, effectively signaling the start of the project.
