Quinoa with plums and lemon



1-1/2 cups quinoa

3 cups chicken broth

6 Italian prune plums, pitted and diced (+ 2 more if you want to add them uncooked before serving)

Zest of 1 small lemon

3 teaspoons fresh lemon juice

Rinse quinoa under cold water and drain well. Place in pot with chicken broth and plums.

Bring to simmer, cover and cook until all of the liquid has been absorbed, 10 to 15 minutes. Remove from heat and add lemon zest and juice.

Serve hot or at room temperature. Add a few diced uncooked plums for some crunch. Makes 6 servings
