## Only 2 new directors for TNRD

Only 2 new Directors were elected to the TNRD Board — Stephen Quinn in Area “B” Thompson Headwaters, and David Laird in Area “M” Beautiful Nicola Valley - North. And 2 Directors were acclaimed — Herb Graham in Area “N” Beautiful Nicola Valley - South, and Mel Rothenburger in “P” Rivers and the Peaks. The remaining 6 directors were re-elected.

The TNRD’s inaugural meeting for the new Board of Directors will take place on Thursday, November 8, at which time they will take their oath of office and elect a new Chair and Vice-Chair.

## Mining news

### Shovelnose Mtn gold find

In late 2017, Westhaven Ventures Inc. discovered a significant highgrade gold-bearing vein system, in the previously underexplored South Zone gold belt of its Shovelnose site. The company is reporting evidence of a significant mineralized alteration system on the property where float samples grading 119 g/t Au (gold) and 273 g/t Ag (silver), veins typical of low-sulphidation epithermal gold deposits, in volcanic rocks located near the southern end of the Spences Bridge Gold Belt (SBGB), approx. 30 km south of Merritt.

Similar epithermal gold deposits have been found in Japan (60-70 g/t Au) & Russia (17.8 g/t Au, 21.8 g/t Ag).

### Nicola Mining’s New Craigmont mine back in the limelight

Nicola Mining Inc., current owner of Craigmont Mine, is preparing to restart milling operations under its long-term Mining and Milling Profit Share Agreement Gavin Mines. They had hoped operations would get going in August but there were delays with mine production. Gavin Mines plans to ship up to 40,000 tonnes of mill feed per year to the Company’s 200 tonne per day mill facility.

Gavin Mines is projecting 11.2 grams Au (gold) per tonne; and 100.8 grams Ag (silver) per tonne. The company expects the mill to commence processing the ores in late 2018 or ealy 2019.

This makes Nicola Mining unique amongst junior mining companies as it expects positive 2019 operational cash flow. Also, it has a silver option to reopen Stope 2 in its Treasure Mountain mine at a relatively low capital cost.
