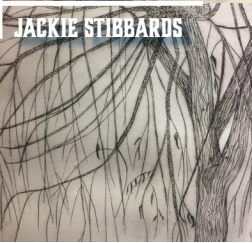

Eco-depot accepts flexible plastic

A new category of recycling is available at all TNRD Eco-Depots. 'Other Flexible Plastic Packaging' is now being accepted which includes stand-up pouches, crinkly potato chip bags and net bags for produce. (This material is accepted at depots only, it is not accepted in curbside recycling).

'Other flexible plastic packaging' is one of the fastest growing packaging types on the market and the largest category of packaging that was previously not collected. Includes: •crinkly wrappers and bags (chip bags, pasta bags, cereal bags, coffee bags, snack and granola bar wrappers); • zipper lock and standup pouches (flexible soap refills, frozen fruit and vegetable bags, zippered produce bags); • non-food protective packaging (bubble wrap, bubble mailers); • flexible packaging with plastic seal (pre-sliced meat and cheese packages); and • woven plastic bags (onion and avocado bags).

Merritt is home to one of the newest endurance mountain bike races, the Merritt Crown — a 120km epic.

"For Canada's 150th birthday, I wanted to create something that celebrated our country's landscape and freedom," explained Darch Osborne, creator of the new epic singletrack mountain biking race in the Nicola Valley. The route links Merritt's 4 distinct riding areas (Coutlee, Iron Mtn, Lundbom, and Swakum Mtn) making a shape similar to a crown. To date, only two riders have completed the challenge: 120 kms of riding, over 11,000 feet of vertical, in less than 12 hours.

They're looking for the next riders to dub King and Queen. If you think you have what it takes to ride the crown, you'll have your chance Saturday, June 22. Darch is an active member of the mountain biking community in Arizona & BC. Last year at the age of 73, he completed the 1000 km-long BC 1000 Epic in 6 days. He has built 15 trails, conducted riding & trail courses, and is now championing Merritt's first endurance race.

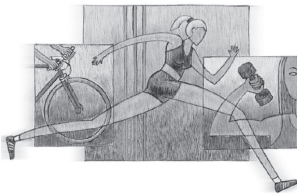
