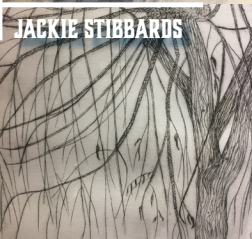

Prescribed burn at Shackan

The BC Wildfire Service and Shackan Indian Band are working together to conduct a prescribed burn on Shackan Indian Reserve #11 to help reduce wildfire risks in the area. The site of the burn is 3km east of the main village of Shackan, 40km west of Merritt.

It is scheduled to start today, Mar 27, if weather, site & venting conditions allow, otherwise it will take place sometime between Mar. 28 & Apr. 15.

Smoke may be visible from nearby communities. The burn will be carefully prepared, controlled and monitored. The low- to moderate-intensity surface fire will be lit within a pre-established boundary to remove combustible materials and mimic a naturally occurring ground fire.

City gearing up for flood readiness

These last few weeks, City employees & elected officials have attended training sessions & workshops on emergency readiness & their Emergency Operations Centre set-up — all in preparation of potential flooding.

They've been working on temporary mitigation measures again this year, awaiting word on their application to the Province for \$150,000 which will go towards permanent mitigation, and additional floodplain & terrain mapping.

TransMtn readies again for start-up

Trans Mountain staff outlined opportunities for local businesses to become suppliers of goods & services for the pipeline project at a local meeting on Monday, hosted by the Chamber of Commerce.

They want to be up & ready to run on May 23, the day after the hoped-for approval of the project to proceed. It would be a few months before we saw much activity in Merritt, with our 'leg' of the pipeline beginning at Black Pines north of Kamloops.

Of the total \$7.4 billion project, a third of that budget will be spent in the BC Interior. For Merritt, it means \$260,000 in tax revenue, plus the community benefit agreement amount, and they also anticipate some property acquisition will be required. They tout employment & business opportunities, for locals & First Nations.
