Snow survey and water supply

For the Nicola region, the snowpack as of April 1 is 'below normal' (66% of normal) after warm & dry weather late last month led to melt of low elevation snowpacks & early onset of the freshet.

Similkameen, Okanagan, & South Thompson also had 'below normal' snow basin indices; northern BC had 'well-below normal' snowpack; and the rest of the province was 'normal'. Nowhere has 'above normal' snowpacks.

Meanwhile, early-April streamflow is generally above normal or well above normal across the Interior, reflecting the onset of freshet 2-6 weeks ahead of normal. El Niño is confirmed to be in full swing, and forecasted to remain strong, extending into the summer and fall.

At this stage in the season the BC River Forecast Centre expects no elevated flood risk with the current snowpack across the province. The seasonal volume runoff forecast is 'below-normal' (<85%) for Nicola Lake. However, May and June are wet months throughout the BC Interior, and flooding could occur with significant rain.
