## Georgina Mary Beatty

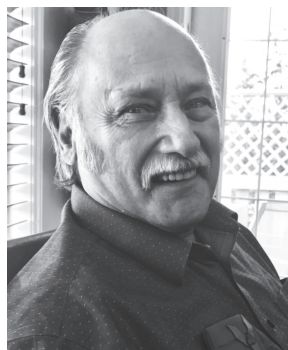
April 27, 1963 - April 12, 2019

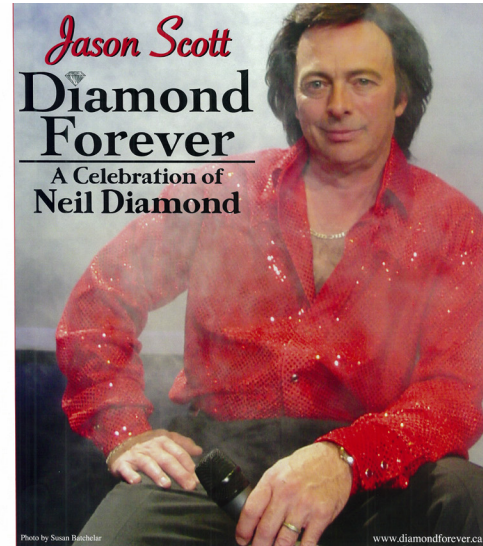
