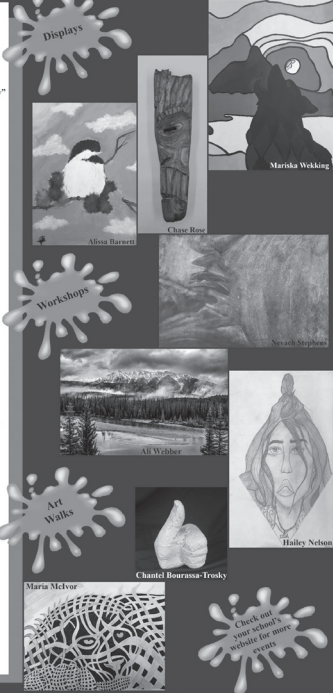

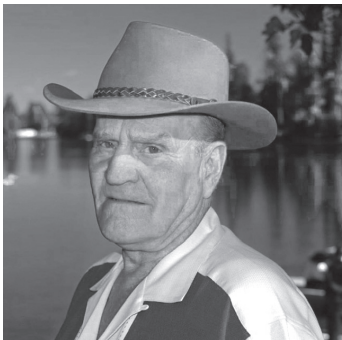

As well, agricultural waste and biosolids were moved from the *prohibited* waste list (outright ban) to the *controlled* waste list (conditions apply for acceptance). 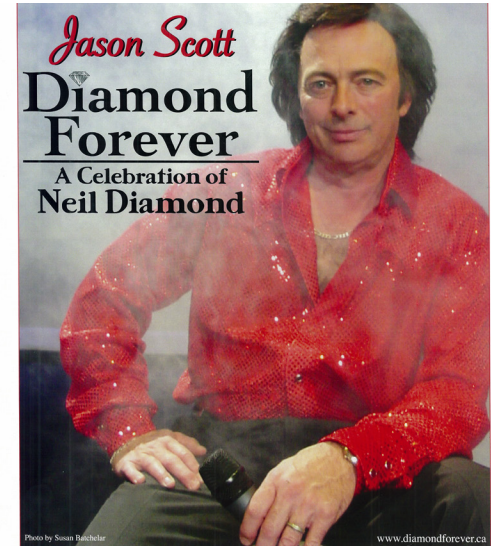

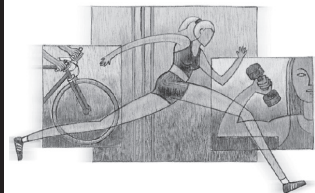
