A late addition to today's Committee of the Whole meeting — a delegation from Nicola Valley Aggregates Ltd. will be presenting to City Council, regarding the proposed gravel pit on Highway 8.

"Council wanted to give the applicant an opportunity to present their side of the debate prior to making any final decisions on whether to send a delegation in objection to the operation," said the note with the agenda addition...

At last week's meeting, council made the decision to write in favour of the nearby residents opposed to the application for a gravel pit permit — and send a delegate to speak against the permit.
