New plans for 4010 Walters St.

At last week's council meeting, the developer presented City Council with a revised plan for 4010 Walters St. The project has been scaled back to 75 units — from the originally-proposed 95 — dropping the 'affordable' units which required a 'housing agreement', license of occupation & a variance. .

The proposed project now consists of 9 bachelor suites, 36 1-bdrm units, 27 2-bdrm units & 3 3-bdrm units. The accommodation is targeted to singles, families, seniors & students.

The redesign means a more streamlined project, that meets all the requirements for high density residential zoning But the project will still require rezoning from C-4 (a rare commercial property along Voght St., according to councillor Bhangu) to R4 High Density Residential; & public hearing.

A traffic study has found that the proposed 75-unit multi-family development would generate less traffic than the current C4 zoning, and that a traffic signal is not warranted within the next 15 years.

The new plans will featured at a public open house, to be held tomorrow, Thurs, June 6, 4-7pm at the Civic Centre.

A public hearing on the development is set for June 25, 7pm at the council meeting, at City Hall.
