## ER 'grand opening' celebrates community participation, art & rainbows

Doors to the new NVGH emergency department opened October 10, 2018. Since that time, other work has been done to finalize the project, including relocating treatment areas into the newly expanded section of the emergency department. This wrapped up in March. Since opening last fall, more than 8500 patients have come through — an average of 35 patients a day, which is expected to increase during the summer months.

With Minister of Health Adrian Dix in attendance, the new facility was 'officially' opened. Part of the celebration is a significant work of art by Okanagan Nation artist Clint George, and 2 rainbow 'crosswalks' — one outside & one inside.

The cost of the emergency department project is approx. \$6.5 million, shared by the provincial government, Interior Health and Thompson Regional Hospital District. The Nicola Valley Health Care Endowment Foundation and Nicola Valley Health Care Auxiliary raised funds from the community for equipment (kudos to everyone who donated!) A donor recognition wall is being installed.
