Update on public lakes access issue

This is an update to inform everyone of recent court activity in the Nicola Valley Fish and Game Club's attempt to restore public access to local lakes and hopefully, this will set a precedent for all lakes in BC.

On June 17th, 2019 in the Kamloops Supreme Court, Justice Joel Groves heard application and responses re: his Dec. 7th, 2018 ruling. He ruled that "until this Court order otherwise or the parties agree, the following is my Order".

First of all, there was no agreement between all "parties" being Douglas Lake Cattle Co., the Province and the NVFG Club. DLCC and the BC Gov't had met and made plans, but our club was not involved. In Court they both stated that the ranch had complied with the Court Order as to the location of the road, lake access, etc. The Ministry of Highways issued a permit to Douglas Lake to remove the logs and boulders they had placed there to block access. Douglas Lake removed some but not all. This left the club wondering what was the reason for this seemingly, useless activity. Next, the government and DLCC agreed that there was a public 3 foot trail that was going to be the only access to Minnie Lake. They both stated that they were working on the trading of the original #281 Stoney Lake road for the existing trail to Stoney Lake. This would effectively eliminate the old road public 66 foot access to Minnie Lake. Our club was understandably upset about not being involved in this process and, as such, the club stated that in Court. The club presented a logical, and the most inexpensive, solution for access to both lakes.

The other main issue disclosed was the club's "costs award". Both the ranch and the government opposed the club's application for "special costs". The Judge finally asked both of them as to who should pay for the club's costs. Douglas Lake suggested a 50/50 split with the government and the government suggested 25/75 split with Douglas Lake paying 75%.

Justice Groves stated that he will make his ruling on July 5th, 2019 at 1:00 pm in the Kamloops Supreme Court.
