As part of the lead up to the *Mayor's Gala for the Arts*, the Canadian Country Music Heritage Society (CCMHS) is planning a "Fan's Choice Award Night" at the Hall of Fame on Friday, September 13th at 7pm.

On the agenda

City Council meeting Aug 27, 7pm

Tomorrow evening will be the public hearing for the bylaw to revoke the cap of 4 cannabis stores in Merritt. It is the first item on the agenda — for Council to hear from the public — then later in the meeting, the bylaw will go to 3rd reading... and, unless there is a great uproar, will be passed. (There was a time when Merritt had the highest-per-capita alcohol outlets... which concerned many people, and was perhaps the reasoning for the cannabis cap in the first place)

The paperwork is back for the re-vamp of business licensing, the long & short of it is this should be more modern & easier to decipher & work with. The changes go towards being more "open for business".

Council will review the Fire and Safety Regulation Bylaw, which for the past 15 years 'prevents any resident from having a campfire, or other form of ambient outdoor fire in any location within Merritt at any time.' The Fire Dept has been consulted & propose to 'create a permitting scheme that would allow small, confined fires (ie. outdoor fireplaces)' in residential areas.

Council will also look at allocating an additional \$80,000 to the Fire Dept, towards purchasing a new combination pumper/tender next year to replace Engine 3, that is 25 yrs old. They'd budgeted \$380,000, but the lowest bid came in at \$479,575. They say that not having that piece of equipment would wreak havoc with 'our ratings with the underwriters'.
