TMX construction will be delayed

Environmental group report says T-M faces detailed route hearings, outstanding provincial permits and Indigenous court challenges

A report from environmental group Stand.earth says it expects construction of the Trans Mountain pipeline expansion to be delayed by detailed route hearings, outstanding provincial permits and Indigenous court challenges.

The Canadian Energy Regulator, formerly the National Energy Board, revoked all previous route approvals in July and required Trans Mountain Corp. to file new notices of its proposed route.

Residents, municipalities and Indigenous groups may then file statements of opposition and the energy regulator decides on a segment-by-segment basis whether to hold detailed route hearings.

Plum salad w/ black pepper & parmesan

2 Tbsp. sherry vinegar or red wine vinegar
1 Tbsp. honey
½ tsp. cracked black pepper
6 ripe plums, some thinly sliced, some cut into wedges
¼ cup shaved Parmesan, + more for serving
2 Tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
Flaky sea salt

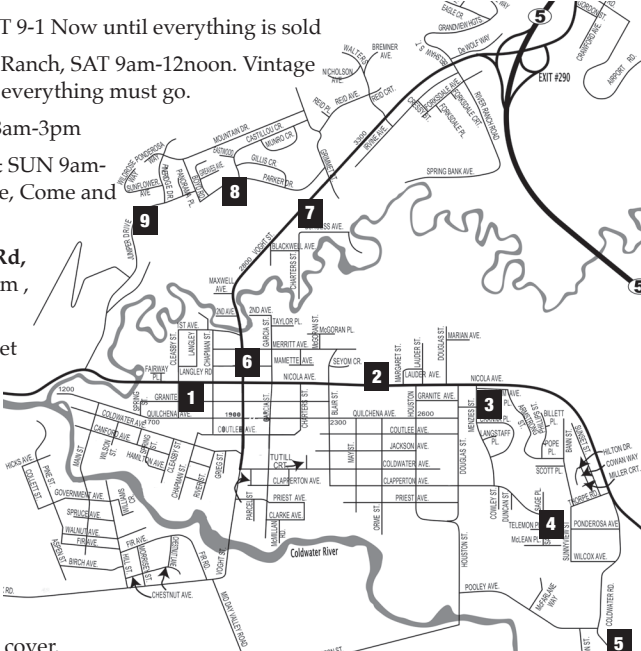


Directions: Stir vinegar, honey, and ½ tsp. pepper in a medium bowl until honey is dissolved. Add plums to dressing and toss until coated. Add ¼ cup Parmesan and gently toss again just to evenly distribute throughout salad. Transfer plum salad to a shallow bowl. Top with more Parmesan, drizzle with oil, and season with salt and more pepper.
