Despite the limited notice on the all-candidates meeting hosted last evening by the Chamber of Commerce, about 60 people attended the NVIT Theatre to hear the 5 candidates weigh in on the issues. What seemed the most memorable...

Allan Duncan - The PPC will “lower taxes, balance the budget in 2 years, no carbon tax” and this will invigorate the economy. These would be paid by selling the pipeline & reduce foreign spending, to mention a few. Our party is the fastest-growing political party ever, with 319 candidates out of the 338 ridings & 40,000 members.

Dan Albas - The Conservatives have a “positive plan for energy self-sufficiency & to make life affordable”, ie age credit, programs to give kids best opportunities. It's important to me to hear all the issues & voices. “I have energy & experience... I love this community, I love the people here. You deserve that voice in Ottawa.”

Joan Phillip - “We have to choose differently: 2 parties have governed for the past 152 years. Canada deserves a government that treats everyone fairly. We have to look forward and take a holistic approach to healthcare, pharmacare, affordable housing.” The top 1% have to contribute more to the bottom 50%.

Mary-Ann Murphy - “There is something terribly wrong in Canadian politics”, people say they are tired of it being fractious & negative. We will “take next steps with the 7 major trade agreements made in 4 years” to diversify export customers. Continue to invest in student loans, new housing, green products, women entrepreneurs.

Robert Mellalieu - “Oil is over”. “Canada is no longer a leader but a laggard & needs to invest not in oil, but in new technology, and upgrade our infrastructure.” “Read science, dig deeper” and “be wary of what politicians say.” The Green Party is proposing a “guaranteed livable income”, instead of subsidies for oil industries.

Thinking outside the box Party Loyalty

A loyalty to a political party can be a problem, if party loyalty prevents each side from recognizing the good in the other, or if bully tactics are employed.

Bully tactics and political ignorance have a correlation and a bully typically doesn't know their own party's platform or their opponent's. Moreover, their political knowledge is primarily gathered from Facebook memes, through conversations with other politically uninformed loyalists, and party pamphlets. Perhaps that's why they rarely present solutions that tackle the root of a problem. Perhaps that's why they bully those who choose another option. Knowledgeable people debate ideas and rarely resort to bully tactics.

The political process is capable of bettering the living standards of an individual, but party loyalties sometimes pit the citizens against each other. The voters should be aligning with progressive ideas and not political brackets, but individual ambitions and the sense of belonging to a gang too often override the ability to reason.

Many party loyalists are so not because they believe in the party colours, but rather in hopes to one-day garner party favour. Perhaps they're looking for a job or desiring the party select him or her to run in a future election. And the party executives are fully aware of a loyalist's ambitions—they dangle the prospects like a carrot on a stick.

In lieu of, when those disenchanted with the eco-social setup do muster the motivation to invoke the political process, in hopes of alleviating their hardships, party loyalties and party rhetoric further alienate their aspirations.

The contemporary political environment has grown too confrontational and bullying is now acceptable. The ancient Romans too suffered under similar divisive circumstances, just before the fall of their empire. They lost it all and we could too if truth, respect, honour, and ethics isn't reintroduced.

The needs of the people should determine for what colour a person casts a vote. Sometimes the nation requires Red, sometimes Orange, sometimes Green & sometimes Blue. In this, the voter must be flexible and willing to change political sides. We must ally with the political party with the best plan to meet present needs. To be stringent with a vote isn't in the best interest of the country.
