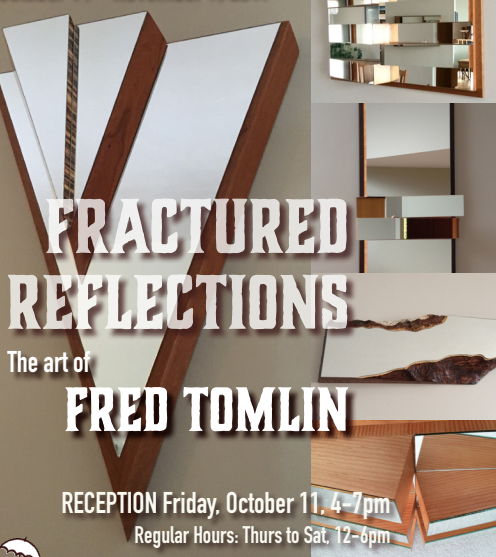

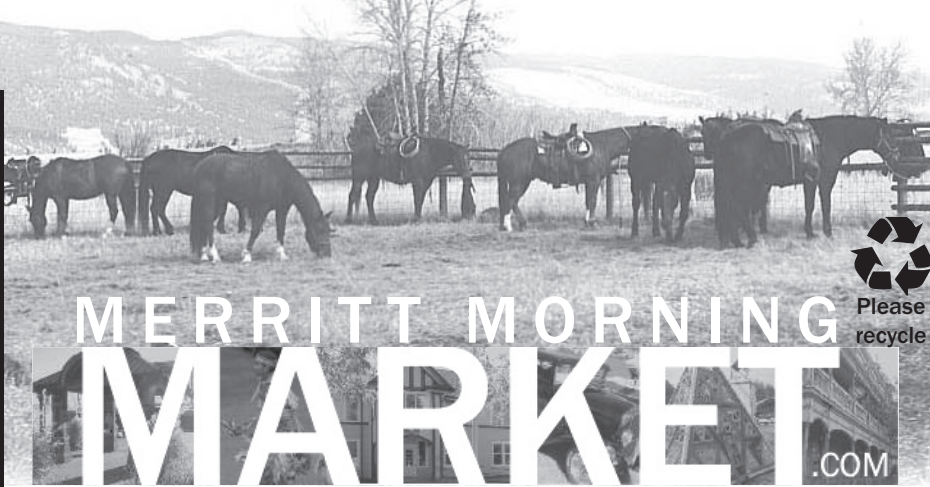

book signing, by Beloved's author, Merritt's Mike Sasges.

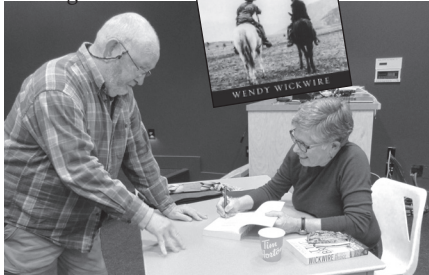

At the Bridge

The gathering was electric last evening, when Wendy Wickwire spoke about her new book *At The Bridge: James Teit and an Anthropology of Belonging*, in the NVIT theatre, one of the stops on her book tour to the BC Interior, where her protagonist made his mark & the story takes place.

While she spoke about her new book, Wendy said it was like “bringing it home.” Many of Wendy’s friends & contacts attended, and she herself became a sort of ‘bridge’ between the little-known anthropologist James Teit and the descendants of the friends & family he found in the Nlaka’pamux people of Nicola Valley & Spences Bridge.

Wendy’s deep roots in the valley mean that friends & acquaintances dating back 4 decades were drawn to attend last night’s event, and their descendants. And because of her interest in the late 1970’s in Teit’s wax cylinder recordings of traditional songs, the 100 years back to the time of *At The Bridge*’s cast of characters — James Teit & the Chiefs of the Allied Indian Tribes of British Columbia — seemed to vanish into an intimate continuum. And Teit’s story is all the more relevant in this time of reconciliation.

...And what a week! I don’t think there has been another occasion in the past 27 years, where there were 2 important book launches/signings with the authors — as there are this week! Thursday, 7pm, don’t miss Mike Sasges at the Seniors Centre, speaking about his new book Once Well Beloved: Remembering a British Columbia Great War Sacrifice about some of the men commemorated on our cenotaph.
