BC is first province to enshrine human rights of Indigenous peoples

Scott Fraser, Minister of Indigenous Relations and Reconciliation, along with First Nations leader, including Grand Chief Stewart Phillip, Union of BC Indian Chiefs: "Today, we have made history. British Columbia is the first province in Canada to enshrine the human rights of Indigenous peoples in law. Bill 41, the Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples act, passed unanimously on Tuesday, Nov. 26, 2019.

"The legislation establishes the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples as the foundational framework for reconciliation in BC, as called for by the Truth and Reconciliation Commission. The provincial government developed Bill 41 in collaboration with the First Nations Leadership Council, which was acting on the direction of First Nations leaders throughout the province. A commitment to adopting the Declaration is a component of the Confidence and Supply Agreement between the B.C. government and the BC Green Party caucus.

"Any future changes to bring provincial laws into harmony with the UN Declaration will be done in consultation and collaboration with Indigenous peoples, with opportunities for engagement with local governments and stakeholders such as business and industry. Changes won't happen overnight – this will be a gradual, step-by-step process over time.

"The development of an action plan – in collaboration with Indigenous peoples – with regular reporting to monitor progress will provide a transparent and accountable path forward on reconciliation in BC.

Missing person found deceased

On Nov. 21, Merritt RCMP entered into a missing person investigation after speaking with the registered owner of a vehicle that was reportedly spotted in a remote location in the vicinity of Glimpse Lake Forest Service Road between Falkland, and Merritt.

On Nov. 22, officers from both the Merritt detachment and Vernon North Okanagan regional detachment launched a ground search of the area surrounding the abandoned motor vehicle for an individual they believed to be associated to that vehicle, and who might be in need of assistance. The search was supported by police canines as well as area search and rescue personnel.

Sadly, just before 11:30am, on Nov. 23, a police canine team located the missing person deceased, within approximately 1km from the vehicle.

At this time, criminality is not suspected in the person's death. The BC Coroners Service is also investigating this sudden death.

"Due to the privacy of the deceased, the BC Coroners Service does not release or confirm identity. The RCMP and BC Coroners Service have no further information available for release at this time," explained Cpl. Jesse O'Donaghey, BC RCMP Communication Services.
