## Albas on Scheer's resignation

Yesterday, Andrew Scheer, at a surprise caucus meeting before heading into the House of Commons, announced he's stepping down as Conservative leader.

Central Okanagan-Similkameen-Nicola MP Dan Albas posted:

"When Andrew Scheer was elected as the Conservative Party leader, I did not expect a call to be asked to join Mr. Scheer's shadow cabinet. However, one of Andrew's first acts as the new leader was to reach out across the caucus and put together a unified Opposition team.

I want to thank Andrew Scheer for his service as both Leader of the Opposition and Leader of the Conservative Party of Canada. It has been a pleasure to work beside him in Shadow Cabinet in the last parliament and in this one.

As a father of four, I also would like to acknowledge and thank Jill Scheer and their five great kids for allowing us to share their husband and father.

I wish him well and look forward to continuing to hold the Liberal Government to account together in this 43rd Parliament."

Sources told the *National Post* that the resignation was pushed forward by the revelation Scheer was using money from the Conservative Party to pay for his children's private school tuition, which was first reported Thursday morning by *Global News*. The Conservative Party pushed back on the allegations shortly after Scheer spoke in the House of Commons, saying it was "normal practice" for parties to cover costs associated with relocating the national leader to Ottawa.

## Elk Gold Project

Representatives from Bayshore Minerals, the current owner of the Elk Gold project, are in their public info phase in preparation for submitting their application for an 11-year open-pit mining permit. They hope to apply by the end of February.

The extensive property is just 1.5km south off the Connector at the Elkhart Lake exit, which means access & transportation don't get much better. Gold deposits were found on the property in the late 1980s, and in 1992-93 50,000 oz of gold was mined — the 'easy' stuff.

The pit where Bayshore Minerals will be working is not as high-grade as what was mined in the 1990s, but by any other standards in the province, it is still be considered 'high grade' at 6.3 grams of gold per ton of ore.

At full production, they estimate taking out 70,000 tons of ore per year, for 11 years (though their longterm plan is for 30 years). They still have to find a mill to process the ore, and mining engineer Grant Carlson said the obvious choice would be at Nicola Mining's Craigmont facility, though a deal has still to be struck.

If the material was taken to Craigmont at Lower Nicola, it would mean 6 truck-&-pup loads per day along Nicola Ave./Hwy 8. They anticipate 15-20 employees on the mine site, and the usual ripple effect through the community with suppliers, etc.

Realistically, if all goes as planned, they expect they could be working by next year this time. Consultation with First Nations is ongoing, and Bayshore Minerals invites input from the public. FMI check their website: bayshoreminerals.com you can also email directly to info@bayshoreminerals.com
