## Coq vehicle fire

A vehicle fire — a semi with its brakes on fire — in the northbound lane of Highway 5, between Merritt's 2 exits (exits 286 and 290), caused major delays last evening, just after 5pm. The right lane of the northbound road was closed, and DriveBC advised drivers to expect delays between 60-90 minutes. The road was cleared by 6pm.

## Neutral El Niño/ Southern Oscillation

???

This is what we are in now... "Neutral El Niño Southern Oscillation (ENSO) conditions have been in place since the summer of 2019, with near-normal or slightly-above normal temperature anomalies along the equatorial Pacific Ocean region."

The River Forecast Centre said: "Warm temperature anomalies have been present in the northern Pacific region through the fall 2019 period. While this pattern is similar in terms of surface conditions during the 2014-16 period (e.g. the "Blob"), analysis by the Climate Prediction Centre (CPC) suggests that the depth of the current warm water pattern is much shallower than during the previous warm anomaly event. A more active period of Pacific storms in late-December and early-January has led to mixing of surface water in the north Pacific, and temperature anomalies have weakened over this period."

They say "there's high likelihood of continued neutral ENSO conditions through the remainder of the winter and into the spring. Neutral ENSO conditions generally have a less predictable association with snow pack conditions in BC, in comparison to El Niño and La Niña conditions. In the last 10-15 years, neutral ENSO winters have been less common, with the last event occurring over the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons."

Given the current ENSO neutral conditions present, it is reasonable to expect increased uncertainty over seasonal weather this winter and spring."
