## Trapped

The contemporary economy forces the  
people to chase their basic needs, each  
person is pitted against the next in their  
chase, and most people are unable to se-  
cure their basics for a prolonged period.

If a person's long-term prosperity, se-  
curity, and potential to meet the basics  
are constantly under threat, as it is under  
a paycheck-to-paycheck reality and a  
life on credit, the mind will do little but  
think about alleviating this threat or the  
mind will stress about it. In such a state  
of mind, a person's awareness naturally  
shrinks and an individual is less likely to  
care for higher values.

The market traps the mind to low-  
er level values, and the person is kept  
so busy by the chase that they have lit-  
tle time and energy to develop a higher  
state of awareness, or even realize that  
there is one. Most people aren't permit-  
ted to grow under the current economic  
circumstances, and most people are only  
sanctioned to maintain an existence.

I'm slightly confused. I thought peo-  
ple entered into a social contract to cre-  
ate the conditions required to secure the  
basics for a prolonged period of time. I  
was under the impression that markets  
and societies came to be so to assist the  
person harness the human condition's  
potential and to help her or him climb.  
This is what many Western Political Phi-  
losophers suggested.

Perhaps that was true in the begin-  
ning, but on the contemporary scene,  
most folks have forgotten why the peo-  
ple entered into a social contract centuries back. And ironically, markets and societies  
have progressed to a point where they're more able than ever to provide the basics to  
all people without an individual having to bust their back.

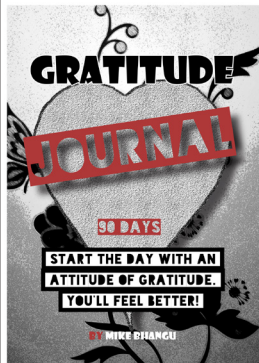
