

Plane crash at the Merritt airport

On Sunday night just after midnight, the RCMP received a missing person report, the investi-

gation of which led to the discovery of a plane wreck at the Merritt airport, with an injured person in the cockpit. With the assistance of the Merritt Fire Rescue Department and BC Ambulance Services, the local Merritt man was extricated from the plane and rushed to the Kamloops Hospital for treatment of serious injuries.

"The City of Merritt Airport is non-towered airport, so flight planning is coordinated through the NAV Canada Flight Information Centre in Kamloops," said the City of Merritt CAO.

NAV Canada was notified that the Merritt Airport was reopened as of 3pm Monday afternoon.

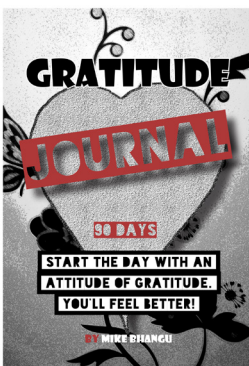
