LNIB gets into power

The Lower Nicola Indian Band Devt Corp. has entered into a partnership with Trans Mountain and Valard Construction to build, own, operate and maintain the new 24-km Kingsvale electricity transmission line that will run through the Band's traditional territory.

The 138-kV transmission line will connect from BC Hydro's distribution line and provide additional power to Trans Mountain's existing Kingsvale pump station, as well as a new Kingsvale pump station that is part of the Trans Mountain Expansion Project.

"This will be the first electricity transmission line to be constructed, majority-owned, operated, maintained and financed by an Indigenous group in Canada. This project will provide valuable economic benefits to the Lower Nicola Indian Band," says Kevin Ainsworth, General Manager of LNIBDC.

LNIBDC holds a majority interest in partnership with Valard and has negotiated a 20-year contract with Trans Mountain to construct the transmission line and interconnection to BC Hydro, as well as own, operate and maintain the line, with the potential of renewing the contract for an additional 20 years.

Thriving Communities

Merritt's own market survey

Work BC wanted to understand the 'unique labour market characteristics of Merritt', in the wake of the forestry crisis. The baseline for completed survey was 100, but after going door-to-door to businesses and doing community outreach, they received 570 replies — putting 'confidence level' at 99%, plus-or-minus 5%!

What they found:

- 100% of employers who participated expect to maintain staffing levels or add new positions through growth.
- Top barriers to employment: lack of prior work experience, education & upgrading skills — associated with "skills mismatch in the marketplace".
- Infrastructure barriers: lack of affordable housing, childcare, transportation.
- On transportation: Merritt employees are more likely to walk to work, than carpool. Commute times are 'far less' than most of the rest of the province (*but we knew that :-)*
- Merritt should see increased jobs at: retail, hospital/nursing/residential care facilities, food services, schools, accommodation services, warehousing/storage.
- Merritt is well positioned to grow in: healthcare, professional/scientific/technical services, mechanic/repair.
- Merritt's #1 emerging industry: cannabis production & products. "Merritt is already proving to be a provincial leader in the cannabis industry. Analysts are pointing to continued opportunity and growth in this industry for years to come. Op #2 emerging industry: green building supplies.
