City to decide on property taxes & utility bills

Council will decide on dates and discounts for residential property taxes & utility bills at tomorrow's Council meeting (you can stream it online from merritt.ca).

For utilities, staff's recommendation is to to increase the 10% discount to 17% for residential & commercial customers, with new payment dates of July 31st & Nov 30th for residential customers.For commercial utilities, they've already decided to lump 1st & 2nd quarter utilities together, with a deadline of Aug. 31st.

For property taxes, staff is recommending 0% penalty to be applied after the July 2 due date, and 5% to be applied October 1, 2020 (to avoid conflicting with a recent Provincial announcement on the

Cheapest gas price in the province!

Over the weekend, Super Save on Nicola Ave. boasted the cheapest gas in the province, at 63.9 cents a litre. All the rest of the gas stations are at 79.9 cents.

Kamloops had the cheapest fuel in the region after Merritt, at 82.9 cents a litre. But the Prince George Costco had it at 68.9 cents a litre, and other stations in PG were at 71.9 cents for regular fuel.

In Vernon it was 85.9 cents, in Kelowna 89.9 cents, in Penticton, 90.9 cents.

may affect workers in Int. Health region
On April 15, Alberta's Chief Medical Officer of Health reported an outbreak of COVID-19 at the Kearl Lake oil sands project, north of Fort McMurray. To date, 12 people connected with this work camp have tested positive.

Many residents in the Interior Health region travel to work camps in Alberta for employment and that there is potential for transmission between communities and between our provinces.

IH medical health officers recommend that people who are contacts or potential contacts from this site self-isolate for 14 days from their last exposure to the site or to

As well, anyone in the community who experiences signs of illness, such as a fever or dry cough, immediately self-isolate for 14 days.

In all communities across IH, we need to assume the COVID-19 virus is present and stay home as much as possible, practise physical distancing, and wash our hands frequently with soap and water to prevent the spread of the illness.




- Maintain a routine: We all feel better, and function bet ter, when we follow a routine. End your workday at the same time as usual and try to go to bed at your usual time as well.



Talking to Kids about COVID-19

Focus on actions you can take. Emphasize safety precautions everyone can take to help keep themselves and others healthy: good hand hygiene, cough and sneeze etiquette, social distancing and staying home if you aren't feeling well.

Stick to routine. Structured days with regular mealtimes and bedtimes are an essential part of keeping kids happy and healthy. Ensure children have time for exercise and fresh air as part of their routines.

Keep talking. Let them know the lines of communication are going to be open and, as you learn more, you will share the information with them
