The symptoms of COVID-19 are similar to other respiratory illnesses, including the flu and common cold. They include **fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**. Other milder symptoms may include: **runny nose, fatigue, body aches (muscles and joints aching), diarrhea, headache, sore throat, vomiting and red eyes**.

**Do I need to be tested if I have symptoms?** The BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool is available for anyone that develops and can be used to help determine if you need further assessment or testing for COVID-19. Go to: <https://bc.thrive.health/>

**Can you become sick from someone before they show symptoms?** There have been a few instances of transmissions before the person became sick or the symptoms were so mild that the person did not know they were sick. However, most people became ill from being in close contact with someone who showed symptoms such as coughing and sneezing, therefore transmitting the virus through droplets.

## Be Bear-Smart

It's the time of year when bears emerge from their dens and search for food, often bringing them into the near-est community.

With more people staying home due to COVID-19 and some waste and recycling services impacted as a result of the pandemic response, it's more important than ever to be vigilant about keeping bear attractants at bay.

While Merritt doesn't have official status through the Bear Smart Community Program, we have been making some progress with bear-proof garbage cans, bear-proof compost containers, and a bylaw against putting garbage containers out the night before pick-up day.

"If bears do not have access to non-natural food sources, such as garbage, fruit and bird seed within communities, they have no reason to hang around. This results in increased safety for both people and bears," said Mike Badry, provincial wildlife conflict manager, BC Conservation Officer Service. "Residents could turn this unusual time into something positive for wildlife by taking extra time to secure attractants and educate themselves about Bear Smart practices."

## COVID guidelines for silviculture workers

BC's provincial health officer has released an order for industrial camps and guidelines to protect people working in the silviculture sector during the COVID-19 pandemic, such as contractors, tree planting operators and their employees.

"Tree planting is crucial to the health of our forests, and we are instituting strict measures based on the PHO's expert direction to make sure that it is done in a way that protects workers and the people of BC," said Doug Donaldson, Minister of For., Lands, Nat. Res. Ops & Rural Devt.

Every year, about 5,000 tree planters, travel to work in remote camps and communities throughout the province. This year, to reduce and mitigate the risks of COVID-19, all tree planters will be subject to strict screening procedures for COVID-19 symptoms before admission to field camps or community accommodations.

Forestry and silviculture were included in the list of essential services because they provide a continuous supply of items, such as wood, pulp and paper, and soft-pulp products, which are like those used to make medical supplies, such as protective masks, drapes and screens.
