### COVID-19 Symptoms & other questions

The symptoms of COVID-19 are similar to other respiratory illnesses, including the flu and common cold. They include **fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**. Other milder symptoms may include: **runny nose, fatigue, body aches (muscles and joints aching), diarrhea, headache, sore throat, vomiting and red eyes**.

**Do I need to be tested if I have symptoms?** The BC COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool is available for anyone that develops and can be used to help determine if you need further assessment or testing for COVID-19. Go to: <https://bc.thrive.health/>

**Can you become sick from someone before they show symptoms?** There have been a few instances of transmissions before the person became sick or the symptoms were so mild that the person did not know they were sick. However, most people became ill from being in close contact with someone who showed symptoms such as coughing and sneezing, therefore transmitting the virus through droplets.

## 2nd COVID-19 death in Interior Health

In follow-up to the provincial report yesterday that there were 168 cases in our health region, Interior Health is “saddened to confirm a second COVID-19 related death in the health authority - a man in his 70s who died on April 27 following an admission to hospital in early April.”

And consistent with all reported COVID-related deaths in BC, Interior Health says it cannot provide additional details.

As of yesterday, there have been 2,053 cases with 1,231 people who had tested positive for COVID-19 having recovered. Of the current COVID-19 cases, 94 individuals are currently hospitalized, 37 of those are in intensive care and the remaining people are recovering at home in self-isolation.

## Food trucks for truckers

Food trucks are being set up at provincially owned locations throughout B.C. to support commercial truck drivers during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Govt of BC is forgoing the usual restrictions and fees for food-truck operators who want to set up on key stops for commercial truck drivers, in locations where it is safe to do so, at the currently reduced traffic volumes. Vendors are operating at rest areas, weigh scales and other commercial truck pullouts throughout the Lower Mainland and southern Interior, with more expected to be added in the coming weeks.

Current locations on provincial property with permitted food trucks, providing commercial truck drivers with more food options during their travels: Nordel CVSE Inspection Station in Delta; Zopkios Brake Check on Hwy 5, approx. 57 km north of Hope; Britton Creek Rest Area on Hwy 5, approx. 62 km south of Merritt; and the Kamloops Weigh Scale at the south outskirts of Kamloops – food served free of cost once per week by the Salvation Army.

Along with allowing food trucks, the Province has recently completed the installation of more than 25 portable toilets at commercial pullouts and inspection stations in the province
