Dam gate opened

On Wednesday afternoon, the City received notice from the provincial dam operator that a gate change had been made to allow an additional 3 cubic metres per second out of Nicola Lake. They expected that between 7 & 11pm that same evening, river levels would rise approx. 3 inches as a result.

Then yesterday, with Nicola Lake above full pool and with inflows still exceeding outflows, notice was given that another gate change would release an additional 3 cubic metres per second. They expected river levels to rise another 3-4 inches last evening.

But even with an additional 7 inches, the City is not anticipating that any residents will experience overland flooding.

They're hoping to slow the rate of rise in Nicola Lake to a point where inflows match outflows over the next few days. Once that happens, river levels can gradually be eased back.

However, with rain overnight & in the forecast again today, the possibility for inflows remain high, making further increases from the dam and flooding still a possibility.

Concerned residents are encouraged to make necessary preparations to protect their property. Pre-filled sandbags are available at the Civic Centre parking lot for anyone who needs them.

Trans Mtn equipment vandalized then torched

Merritt RCMP is investigating after a piece of heavy equipment on the TMX site near Merritt was the target of vandalism and theft one day, and the subject of a suspicious blaze another.

On Tuesday during the early morning hours, police received a report of a suspicious vehicle fire, after crews discovered a blue Peterbuilt rope truck had burned. The blaze resulted in a total loss of the truck, valued at \$1 million. The same vehicle had been targeted in an act of mischief and a theft of fuel earlier in the weekend.

The fire scene was secured for a full examination completed by forensic specialists and fire investigators with the RCMP Southeast District General Investigation Section. They have since learned that there were individuals camping over the weekend in the immediate area of the impacted vehicle. GIS investigators are seeking to identify those campers, as they may hold key information.

Police are also asking motorists who may have travelled through the area of Hwy 5A and Tillery Rd, outside of town on the evening of May 18 into the early morning hours of May 19, to review their dash camera footage and contact police. At this stage, it is unknown whether the acts were targeted in nature or simply crimes of opportunity.
