



TESTING FOR PEOPLE WITH SYMPTOMS

B.C.'s testing COVID-19 strategy has been expanded to include anyone with cold, influenza or COVID-19-like symptoms, however mild. The symptoms of COVID-19 are similar to other respiratory illnesses including the flu and common cold. They include: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, painful swallowing, stuffy or runny nose, loss of sense of smell, headache, muscle aches, fatigue, loss of appetite. Anyone who needs a test should call their primary care provid er (family doctor or nurse practitioner) or the closest Interior Health community testing and assessment centre directly to arrange a test. 
