## “We got lucky with the weather!”

For the first time in what feels like a  
long time, we got lucky with the weather!  
The Nicola Basin appears to have  
received far less rain during Saturday's  
storm than what was forecasted. Provin-  
cial weather station data indicates that  
Merritt and Helmer Lake areas (which  
feeds Mill Creek) received 20-30mm of  
rain, but the Nicola Basin looks to have  
only received 5-15mm. By comparison,  
forecasts for the Nicola Basin ranged  
from 20-60mm of rain.

The Nicola River levels rose another  
3-6 cms over the course of yesterday, due  
to increased flows from Mill Creek. But  
should the weather hold, the dam operator  
indicates that there are no plans to  
further increase outflows from the dam.

The Coldwater River rose over the  
weekend, from 37 cubic metres per second  
(cms) to over 80cms. And they were  
expected to peak around noon yesterday.  
That, however, caused no flooding, but  
residents are warned to stay away from  
the river as it is high and moving quickly.

Rain is forecasted again for tomorrow,  
so while flood risk has decreased with the  
passing of this weekend's storm, we remain  
vulnerable and the City is encouraging residents  
living along the rivers to stay vigilant.

## Report: Sediment af- fecting fish habitat

An investigation by BC's independent  
forestry watchdog has found that  
sediment from roads posed a high risk  
to fish habitat in 3 of 5 watersheds it as-  
sessed, including the Pennask watershed  
between Merritt and Kelowna.

Some industry practices were quite  
good, such as maintaining fish passage  
during road work, but more must be  
done to prevent sediment from winding  
up in streams, according to the report.

Sediment management should be con-  
sidered from the time a road is designed  
through to its construction to its deactivation.  
The board's investigation found risk  
was also high in the Ainslie watershed  
near Boston Bar, the Owen watershed near  
Houston, as well as Pennask. The report  
says most of the contributing factors could  
have been avoided by following well-es-  
tablished best practices for erosion and sediment control. The watchdog is recommending  
the province amend the Forest and Range Practices Act to ensure clear and enforceable  
requirements for minimizing the sediment entering streams during road work.
