Update: Oliver farm COVID-19 outbreak

Interior Health's Medical Health Officer has issued an order for the Krazy Cherry Fruit Co. in Oliver due to 2 positive COVID-19 cases associated with this farm. However, Krazy Cherry is permitted to continue to operate, pick, pack and sell cherries.

Interior Health does not have concerns about a health risk to individuals consuming produce from Krazy Cherry Fruit Co.

There is currently no evidence that COVID-19 is foodborne disease and as such it cannot be caught by eating food products. Covid-19 does not live on surfaces for prolonged periods of time at this site, the cherries are in contact with a 20ppm chlorine solution. Spread of COVID-19 through food packaging has not been documented.

General recommendations for the public purchasing ANY fresh produce: •As always we recommend washing fruit products and hands prior to consumption. •Rinse fresh produce like cherries under cold water (note: we don't advise soap or sanitizer on produce at consumer level). •Always wash your hands with soap and water before and after eating.

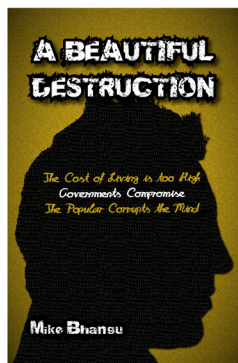
