Merritt appoints new CAO

In the wake of Scott Hildebrand moving on to TNRD, Merritt City Council has appointed Sean Smith, as the new CAO, effective August 10.

Sean has served as the Director of Corporate Services for the City of Merritt since 2017 and took on additional responsibilities as Deputy CAO in 2019. Prior to his work with the City, he worked as a lawyer for a municipal law firm in Victoria. Sean holds a Juris Doctor degree from UVic and an Economics (BA) degree from the UBC.

Mayor Brown said, "residents will appreciate Sean's energy, commitment to providing exceptional service, and genuine desire to make the City of Merritt the most dynamic small community in British Columbia. Council has relied on him heavily over the past few years and he has proven himself time and again. Ordinarily, Council would conduct an expansive search to find a CAO, but in this case, Council's decision to hire Sean was easy."

New Community Policing officer

The Merritt RCMP detachment has selected Constable David Feller to be the new Community Police/Street Enforcement Unit officer. An internal competition was held for the position and Cst. Feller was the selected candidate. Cst. Feller will be replacing Cst. Tracy Dunsmore who had held the position for over 10 years, he will assume his duties in early August.

Cst. Feller has been with the Merritt detachment for 2.5 years and is eager to hit the ground running. Cst. Feller will be a visible presence in the downtown core and will be conducting foot/bike patrols and other preventative policing measures to ensure the downtown is a safe and pleasant area for everyone. Cst. Feller will also be responsible for partnerships with our local schools and community groups.

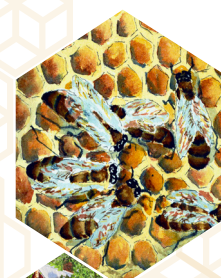
