City recognizes Darius Sam

Yesterday just before the first in-person council meeting, Merritt City Council presented a *Citizens Recognition Award* to Darius Sam for his personal marathon & fundraising efforts for the Nicola Valley Food Bank last month.

Darius thanked his support team — family, friends & trainer — as well as Hilde Rose & the Rose family, who matched his \$35,000 GoFundMe tally at that time. The donations have continued to roll in to the Food Bank, and manager Derlanda Hewton confirmed that donations now sit at \$108,000!

Skuhun Creek fire

The Skuhun Creek wildfire burning west of town near the Dot Ranch Cut-off Rd. and Shackan, had grown to 28 hectares yesterday. It is burning ‘out of control’ in steep, rocky terrain. It was discovered Monday by a Min. of Hwys crew member on patrol along Hwy 8.

Yesterday, there were 63 provincial firefighting personnel on site & 2 helicopters. No structures are currently at risk, and the cause fire’s is under investigation.

The BC Wildfire Service is also responding to a new wildfire at Mathew Creek, approx. 10 kms southeast of Brookmere. Yesterday, it grew to an estimated 4 hectares in size. 24 BCWS personnel are responding with the support of airtankers and heavy equipment. It is suspected to be person-caused.

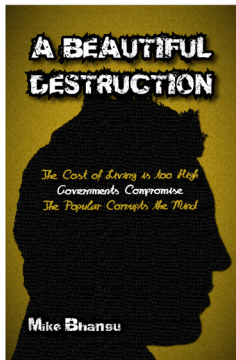
