Illicit drug deaths continue to rise

The BC Coroners Service has published
updated reports on illicit drug toxicity
deaths & fentanyl-detected drug deaths to
the end of July 2020, with 175 illicit drug
toxicity deaths reported in July. This is the
third consecutive month with more than
170 suspected illicit drug deaths.

July's total (175) represents a 136% in-
crease over the number of deaths seen in
July 2019 (74). The BC Coroners Service
has detected a sustained increase of illicit
drug toxicity deaths since March, and the
province has now recorded 5 consecutive
months with over 100 illicit drug toxicity
deaths.

Once again, post-mortem toxicology
testing data published in this report sug-
gest an increase in the number of cases
with extreme fentanyl concentrations
(exceeding 50 micrograms per litre) in
April, May, June and July 2020 compared
with previous months.

"The number of people dying in B.C.
due to an unsafe drug supply continues to
surpass deaths due to homicides, motor
vehicle incidents, suicides and COVID-19
combined," said Lisa Lapointe, chief cor-
oner. "This health emergency continues
to take a tragic toll on people from all
walks of life and in all communities of
the province. Access to key harm reduc-
tion services in the midst of a dual health
emergency has been a challenge, and the
extreme concentration of the illicit fentan-
yl being trafficked is resulting in deaths
within moments of use."

There have been 909 illicit drug deaths
to date in 2020 in B.C., and the number
of deaths in each health authority is at
or near the highest monthly totals ever
recorded. The number of non-fatal over-
dose incidents is also increasing, with a
record high of more than 2,700 calls re-
ported by BC Emergency Health Services
(BCEHS) in July.
