## Coldwater R. basin driest in the province

The Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resources Operations and Rural Development says the Coldwater River basin is experiencing extreme levels of drought — it is the only area in the province with that rating.

There is only one region at Drought Level 3 — eastern Vancouver Island — with basically the rest province experiencing normal moisture conditions.

This latest extreme drought level is even more advanced than when the City of Merritt put in additional watering restrictions on August 21st.

## Aaron Sumexheltza to carry NDP banner in Fraser-Nicola

The former chief of the Lower Nicola Indian Band will represent the NDP in Fraser-Nicola in the next provincial vote. The governing party confirming Aaron Sumexheltza yesterday. He had sought the NDP nomination in Fraser-Nicola ahead of the 2017 election but former MLA Harry Lali won the spot at that time. Aaron is a lawyer and now serving as councillor for the Lower Nicola band.

Comments this week from Premier Horgan have lead to speculation that he could call a snap election this fall. His popularity in the polls is running high, but pundits question whether it will remain that way as the pandemic continues.

## Jim Pattison Broad- casting Group applies to purchase Q101

The CRTC is asking the public for input into the proposed sale of Merritt Broadcasting Ltd. to the Jim Pattison Broadcast Group (JPBG). Merritt Broadcasting operates Q-101 FM.

As part of the sale, the staff at Q-101 FM will be offered the opportunity to continue in their current roles at the radio station. JPBG says the deal was largely negotiated prior to the arrival of the COVID-19 pandemic.

JPBG owns and operates more than 40 radio stations, 3 television stations & numerous websites across western Canada.

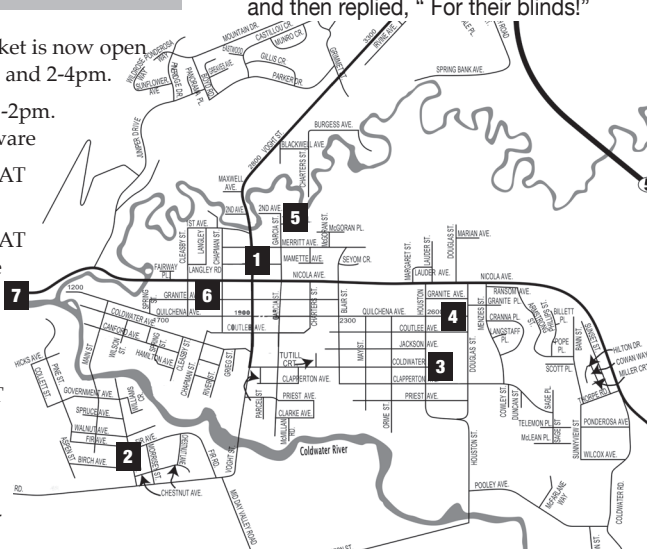
