## Gateway 286 to be transferred to Nicola First Nations

The Province is set to transfer 11 hectares (approx. 25 acres) of Crown land to the Nicola Valley First Nations, fulfilling a promise made in March 2019 to work together to grow the regional economy and advance reconciliation with the First Nations. The land lies at the intersection of the Coq & Okanagan Connector, site of the Visitor's Centre which closed in January 2018.

It will be transferred via Spayum Holdings, a consolidated development corporation controlled by all five Nicola Valley First Nations: Upper Nicola, Nooaitch, Coldwater, Shackan, and Lower Nicola.

Spayum plans on investing \$40 million and creating hundreds of permanent and temporary jobs during development of the site. The development will also re-open the landmark Merritt Gateway rest stop for travellers on the Coquihalla.

The parcel is key to the First Nations' development strategy, which will support the economic and social health of the Nations, help build community strength and well-being and promote the First Nations' culture and history.

The five bands have been trying to acquire the lands for more than 20 years.

## Plum caprese salad



A twist on the traditional caprese salad, but still simple and seasonal.

### Ingredients

- 1 lb ripe plums — right now there are TONS of beautiful & delicious Italian prune plums on trees all around town!
- Cherry tomatoes (optional)
- 8 oz burrata, or bocconcini/fresh mozzarella
- 1 cup fresh basil leaves
- 1 cup fresh mint leaves (optional)
- Good extra virgin olive oil to taste
- Balsamic vinegar
- Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

### Instructions

Slice the plums in half and remove the pits. Slice into rounds. Add tomatoes, if using. Scatter half of the basil and mint leaves on a platter. Then arrange the plum rounds on top, leaving room in the center for the burrata.

Sprinkle with remaining herbs. Place the burrata in the center. Generously drizzle with olive oil & balsamic vinegar, and season generously with kosher salt and pepper.
