

## Candidates are now official

The deadline to submit the paper-work for candidates in next month's election was on Friday. It's now official: Aaron Sumexheltza is running as a BC NDP, Jackie Tegart for the BC Liberal Party, Jonah Timms for the BC Green Party, and Dennis Adamson & Mike Bhangu are running as independents.

In total, there are 310 candidates across the province, most running for official parties, but 21 in all are running as independents. And out of the 87 ridings, only ours, Fraser Nicola, has 2 independent candidates...
