Cluster of drug overdoses in Merritt

The Merritt RCMP are wanting to make the public aware of a cluster of drug overdoses that have occurred earlier in the week. Police are looking into the source of the drugs. The circumstances of the overdoses are leading the RCMP to believe that the opioid presently in the Merritt supply chain is substantially more potent and/or a different composition than previously available.

Merritt RCMP have been out advising the drug users of the immediate threat. Police are also advising the public that should they find drugs or drug paraphernalia on the ground, please call the police and do not handle it.

The looming TMX

This week, at the same time the Canadian Centre for Policy Alternatives published a report *Reassessment of Need for the Trans Mountain Pipeline Expansion Project*, pipeline construction newsletters were in our mailboxes, outlining the work & timelines for our area for the next 2 years.

The CCPA report concludes "announced expansions of existing pipelines including the Enbridge Mainline, along with completion of Enbridge's Line 3 in 2021, will create more than enough pipeline export capacity for Canadian oil producers through 2030, and through 2040 and beyond if some of Western Canada's rail capacity is used."

Meanwhile, the camp being developed will house approx. 400 workers on the Ranchlands area of Chutter Ranch, expected to be operational until Oct 2022. It will provide accommodation, laundry, dining, medical services, recreational opportunities, power and internet, and transportation to & from the worksite. TM is currently in negotiations about water & sewer with the City of Merritt.

The estimated cost of completing the entire expansion project was originally estimated at \$7.4 billion, but in February the budget had grown to \$12.6 billion.

Letter Cops for Kids follow-up

The 20th Annual Cops for Kids ride was completed on September 20, 2020. This was my third year that I have participated in the ride. Although this year, with Covid in play, it was quite different than others. In light of social distancing constraints the riders were essentially tasked with completing the 1000 km ride alone or in small teams of 6. In past years we were able to ride in a group of up to 30 riders. I am pleased to announce that many of the riders still took on the challenge. We were able to keep each other up to date on social media and phone calls.

Part way into the ride the wildfire smoke became a considerable health concern and the ride was postponed for a number of days. All the riders stayed committed. Some rode indoors while others travelled to areas with better air quality and rode there. The level of commitment that the ambassador families instill in the riders is amazing. Through all of this the ambassador families do not get to take days off for poor air quality of Covid concerns. They push on doing what they have to do for their children. Truly inspiring.

Through all of this I want to mention that the community of Merritt and its citizens pulled through and sponsored my ride at a rate higher than any of the other years. I cannot express how much this means to me and the ambassador families. As the pledges came in I was able to brag to the larger group about this community of Merritt. Please know that your donations are going to very deserving families. The overhead of this charity is kept extremely low so that the funds get to the families. I am so proud to be a part of this ride and a citizen of Merritt.
