## Merritt RCMP take down illegal grow op



After a tip-off from a motorist, Merritt RCMP opened an investigation into a large rural cannabis grow operation in the area, off Hwy 8. Health Canada advised the Merritt RCMP that the rural property did not have a cannabis or hemp authorization on the property.

Police executed a search warrant under the Cannabis Act on Friday, October 30, in conjunction with Central Interior Traffic Services, RCMP Air Services, RCMP Provincial Cannabis Coordinator, RCMP Indigenous members and a local contractor.

Over 100,000 plants were destroyed on site, with an estimated dried and processed value of \$8 million.

## COVID-19 numbers in Int. Health November 3

11 additional COVID-19 cases were reported in Interior Health overnight, bringing the total in IH since the start of the pandemic to 788 (as there were 36 reported on Monday, since Friday).

95 cases are active and on isolation. No one is in hospital.

Provincially, the Min. of Health reported 299 yesterday, on the heels of 1,120 new cases for the Fri-Mon period.

## skiesmag.com The first trans-Canada flight

[Editor: Last month was the 100th anniversary of the first trans-Canada flight. Interestingly, Merritt played a role in the event. This is an excerpt of the local bits, part a longer & very interesting story!]

"One hundred years ago, an intrepid group of Canadian aviators completed a significant nation-building effort – the first crossing of Canada by air. The flight began at Canadian Air Board Station Dartmouth, N.S., at 8 a.m. on Oct. 7, 1920, and touched down at Minoru Park Race-track in Richmond, B.C., at 11:25 a.m. on Oct. 17 — having flown nearly 5,400 kilometres (3,355 miles) in 10.5 days and logging just over 49 hours of flying time.

In early August 1920, approval was given by the Canadian Air Board to carry out a transcontinental flight using relays of aircraft to be flown from Halifax to Vancouver.

Letters were loaded on the aircraft from mayors across the country addressed to Vancouver's mayor. As each leg of the flight was completed, the bag of letters was carefully transferred to the next aircraft in the transcontinental relay

... The leg from Calgary to Vancouver presented significant challenges, both from the altitude of the mountain passes and the poor weather. On Oct. 12, Thompson and Tylee were weathered in. The following day, they eventually got away from Calgary and headed into the Rockies. They crossed the Selkirk via Rogers Pass, but west of Revelstoke, B.C., they were turned back by heavy snowstorms and eventually landed at Crowle's ranch.

Oct. 14 was another weather day, but on Oct. 15 the flight continued. After crossing the Monashees via Eagle Pass, they were forced back by fog and landed at Merritt, BC.

An attempt to cross the Cascades was made the next day, but the airmen were turned back once again. Finally, on Oct. 17, the weather in the Coquihalla Pass opened sufficiently to allow the aircraft to slip into the Fraser Valley in B.C. At 11:25 a.m., they touched down at the Minoru Park Racetrack in Richmond, where the fliers were greeted by the Mayor of Vancouver, R. H. Gale." — Retired colonel John L. Orr
