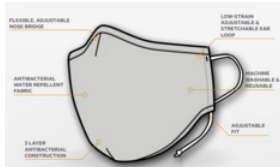

Urgent letter from Merritt doctors 2nd wave

How many seriously ill COVID-19 cases at once would it take to overwhelm Nicola Valley Hospital? Not many. We operate best with only 1 very sick person at a time needing our full attention. If our hospital has 3, 5, or 10 cases at once, no one who subsequently enters the ER for any reason can be served. Medical response to heart attacks, pneumonia, trauma, and many other ailments could be delayed. Our community's health care system requires a delicate balance and we must not allow it to become overwhelmed.

People of Merritt are not immune. We are literally and figuratively at a crossroads, still basking in the afterglow of a light first wave in this pandemic, while travellers from increasingly case-heavy regions continuously pass through our grocery stores, gas stations, shops and restaurants. Locals are still socializing outside their bubbles. The numbers are frightening. COVID-19 counts are dwarfing those of the first wave in many parts of Canada. We can see the 2nd wave coming this way.

The doctors of Merritt once again appeal to you all: Do not let your guard down. Do not become complacent. We can not do this alone. Saving lives depends on YOUR ACTIONS. If we are not way ahead of this, we are behind.

There is no need to spread fear or confront others. But please be smart:

1) Superheroes wear a mask in public – and the evidence is now clear that transmission will be seriously reduced if you do too.

2) Like a zombie apocalypse, develop your social distance instinct and avoid crowds. Limit your contacts. Anyone you see could be infected. You might be next.

3) Hygiene helps: Continue your hand washing routine. Use sanitizer. Be aware of high-touch surfaces, such as handling gas pumps.

4) Home sweet home! Avoid needless travel. Shop locally. Be social online but skip pandemic conspiracy theories in favour of legitimate medical sources. Help your neighbours from a healthy distance.

We care deeply about our community & this crisis is unlike anything we have ever experienced. We are all in this together.
