

Hot topic: water

Unusual for me to agree

I want to see water stats from Public Works before I believe the report that there is a 43.3% decrease in per person water use between 2006 and 2019. "Water use is trending in the right direction."

Councils have always been reluctant to decrease summer watering instead opting to wait for the Govt.

I would suggest Council and staff review the "Adaptive Water Management" report from Compass Resource Management Ltd. May 2012.

There are numerous other Policies and Public works consumption stats as far back as 1995.

Currently, according to the Water Utility Master Plan, Merritt can see population growth of up to 14,496, (roughly 7,400 more than the current number), even if usage were increased to 880 l/p/d. There is also sufficient storage to support a population of 14,496. However, if developments proceed at higher elevations such as Exit 286 or the North Bench, additional reservoirs or similar alternatives would likely be needed to ensure adequate water pressure.

Editor, your reporter missed the import of the Council Committee meeting of Dec 1, in addition to misunderstanding the current challenges for further development of Merritt.

Everyone knows that we have been unable to supply our current population with potable water in the driest periods; and we certainly will not be able to supply an additional 7000 residential units without very costly well development, storage capacity increases, increased conservation — or a combination of these initiatives. The article did not advise that the 2012 Water Master Plan is no longer viable; as recent Water Management regulations require protecting the Coldwater drainage, and flow--largely to protect salmon, and to replace our groundwater supply underneath Merritt. So, additional development WILL require new wells, AND also conservation. And those new wells will likely be drilled into the lower and middle aquifers; costly propositions — and, based upon the Kengard well, fraught with manganese contamination. It's not going to be an easy, nor cheap 'fix' if Merritt expands (which Council seems hell-bent on doing — at any cost).

The least costly, and the lowest impact on our environment, may be conservation. The City needs a method of metering residents' consumption — so we only pay for what you use; not for our profligate neighbour with his swimming pool, large lawn, etc. But, if new wells and storage tanks are needed (if we approve more dwellings); let's get the developers to pay for them — not we existing taxpayers, who have suffered with water restrictions and Nicola River flooding for years.

We'd better think carefully about what size will be desired, and be cost-effective, for a future Merritt.
