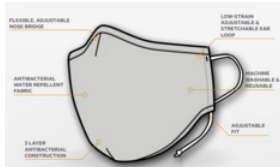

A public hearing in the time of COVID

The rezoning application public hearing for the 370+ residential project in Colletville will be held next Tuesday. Things will be handled differently than normal, due to the COVID restrictions.

Council will meet in their Chambers at 6pm on Tuesday January 12, and the meeting will be live broadcast on the City's website: www.merritt.ca

You can give your input 2 ways:

Written submissions (These can always be made to a public hearing, and they're particularly encouraged at the moment. A written submission always has just as much weight as someone who speaks in person.) They've extended the deadline for these until 5pm the day before the hearing. Physically write a letter & use the drop box on the side of the City Hall building, or mail to City of Merritt, Box 189, Merritt, BC V1K 1B8; or email planning@merritt.ca — either one works, please clearly mark for the public hearing on Jan 12th.

Video or audio submissions (This is more experimental & a first for public hearings) Submit video or audio recording of your views, as a substitute to speaking in person. Use the cameras / microphones on your phones, tablets, webcams, etc. These can then be dropped off or mailed into City Hall on a USB stick, or uploaded to a person's youtube / other video site account and email the link to them, or submitted to the City's facebook messenger account. Or call City Hall at 378-4224, and leave a voicemail for Greg Lewis or Don McArthur, clearly stating it is for the public hearing on the 12th.

If these ways don't work for you, please contact Director of Corporate Services Greg Lewis on his direct line (378-8614) to discuss another way of sending a virtual submission.

"I'd emphasise that written submissions are always valid, even if nothing else works, and can be written and sent in at any time of day or night, any day of the week — so should work for just about everybody," explained Greg.

COVID-19 numbers in Int. Health January 7

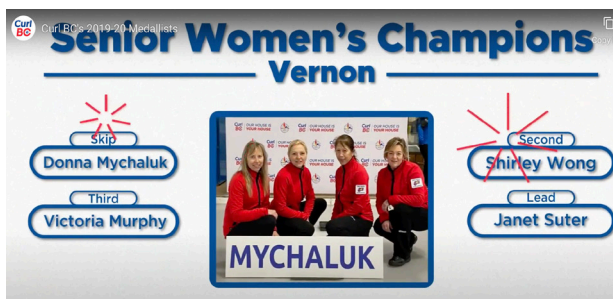
IH is reporting 96 new cases overnight for a total of 4,406. 822 cases are active and on isolation. 33 people are in hospital; 8 of them in ICU. Total number of deaths in IH has risen to 35.

There are currently 10 outbreaks in Interior Health, primarily in long-term care facilities. And for the most part, the deaths have occurred in these facilities.

The info for cases by community has been updated as well. Merritt has had 9 new cases in the past week, and a cumulative total of 39 from Jan 2020 to Dec 2020.

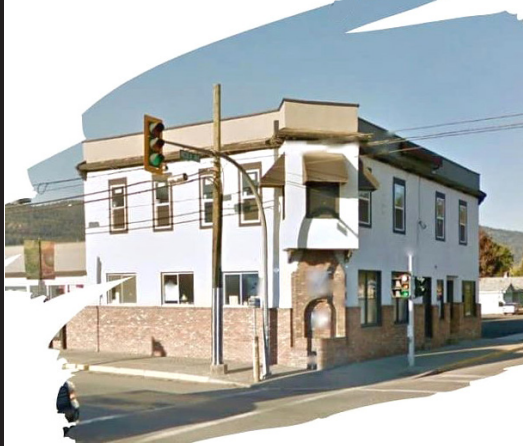
