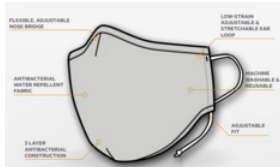

Public hearing for Lindley Crk Rd project rescheduled to January 26, 5pm

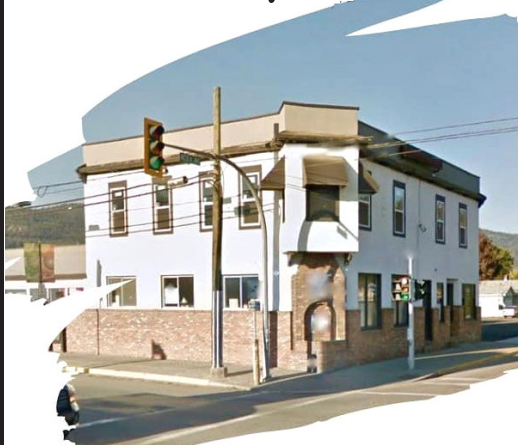
