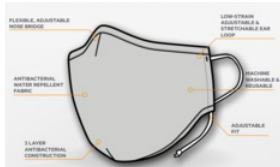

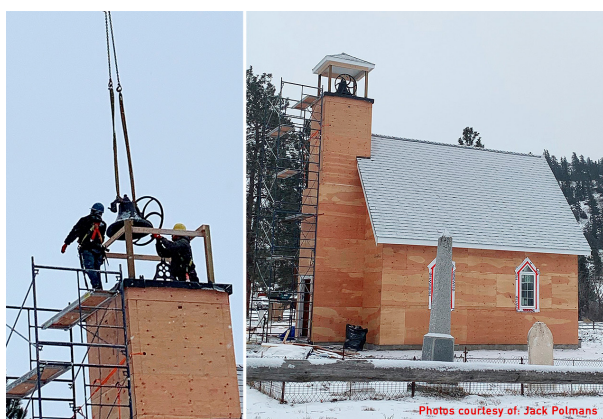

## COVID-19 numbers in Int. Health January 28

70 new COVID-19 cases were reported in Interior Health yesterday - the total in IH since the start of the pandemic is now 6080. 1029 cases are currently active and on isolation. 48 people are in hospital, 17 in ICU. Total recovered to date 4972. Total confirmed deaths to date 69.

The Royal Inland Hospital outbreak in unit 6 South (a surgical unit) was declared last Friday and now has 71 cases: 25 patients and 46 staff, and 1 death.

Interior Health officials say the hospital is safe to attend for appointments or emergency care. Please continue with any scheduled procedures and COVID-19 self-isolation is not required after visiting the hospital.
